MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO.26 HELD ON NOVEMBER 08,2021


Leaf offerings stood at 48,941 packages alongwith 3,105 packages of leaf supplements. Market eased as demand declined. Leaf withdrawals stood at 43% as against 27% last week.


LEAF: Better brokens were generally easier by Tk.4/5. Medium and the plainer teas depreciated by Tk.5/8. Northern brokens were in less demand and met with large withdrawals and where sold, ranged between Tk.160/- to Tk.176/-. Selective best lines sold between Tk.209/- to Tk.217/ and 3 lines between Tk.247/- to Tk.275/-.

Good fannings eased by Tk.3/5. Mediums fell further and the plainer lines declined by Tk.7/8 or more. Northern fannings met with large withdrawals. Few lines sold between Tk.167/- to Tk.175/-. Selective best lines fetched between Tk.210/- to Tk.218/-and 4 lines between Tk.223/- to Tk.254/-.

<u>DUST</u>: 10,104 packages were on offer alongwith 1,111 packages of supplements. There was a satisfactory demand although prices eased by Tk.3/5. Dust withdrawals stood at 31% as against 24% last week.

SALE NO:- 27 will be held on November 15, 2021 at 8:30 A.M. in Chattogram. Total offerings will comprise of 51,822 packages leaf and 11,299 packages dust.

COMMENTS: Better teas on offer were easier by Tk.3/5. Most others were easier by Tk.5/8 and often more. With the progress of sale, prices kept on falling as demand progressively eased. Packeteers were more selective and shared freely. Local traders were rather subdued in the leaf section but lent more support for the dusts. Overall quality showed a seasonal decline.
