MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO.27 HELD ON NOVEMBER 15,2021


48,654 packages leaf alongwith 3,100 packages of leaf supplements came under the hammer in this sale. Market opened at little easier rates but declined sharply with the progress of sale. Leaf withdrawals stood at 43% as against 43% last week.


LEAF: Well made brokens were initially about a firm market. Mediums and the lower types were easier by Tk.3/5. As the sale progressed prices kept on falling with very large withdrawals. Northern brokens were in less demand and eased by Tk.8/10 with very large withdrawals and generally sold between Tk.153/- to Tk.167/-. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.209/- to Tk.222/- and four lines sold between Tk.251/- to Tk.262/-.

Good fannings too were about firm when the sale opened. Others were easier by Tk.4/5. With the progress of sale, most fannings eased by Tk.5/8. Northern fannings sold between Tk.155/- to Tk.168/. Selective best lines sold between Tk.209/- to Tk.226/- and two lines between Tk.250/- to Tk.253/-.

<u>DUST</u>: 10,039 packages alongwith 650 packages of supplements were up for sale. There was a fair demand at lower rates than last. Good CD's were a strong market. Dust withdrawals stood at 34% as against 31% last week.

SALE NO:- 28 will be held on November 22, 2021 at 8:30 A.M. in Chattogram. Total offerings will comprise of 52,062 packages leaf and 12,605 packages dust.

COMMENTS: Market opened at little easier rates but the better lines were about firm. But as the sale moved forward, prices eased with a larger volume remaining unsold. Northern teas met with large withdrawals and where sold, generally realised between Tk.153/- to Tk.168/-. Packeteers and the local traders were much weaker than last.
