**LEAF-CTC:**

**Brokens:** Well-made, good liquoring types were absorbed by the Blenders at firm to slightly easier rates. Below best and mediums sold at easier rates of Tk 1/2. Plainer types sold about similarly with some withdrawals.

**Fannings:** Best types sold well at firm to generally little easier rates. Others met with fair demand at rates Tk 1/2 below last. Plainer types witnessed some withdrawals.
