LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well-made good liquoring types sold well but were generally easier by Tk. 2/3 and occasionally more. Below best and the mediums met with less demand and sold at rates Tk 3/5 below last. Plainer types eased similarly with fairly large withdrawals.

Fannings: Best and the below best types met with a fairly good demand at levels Tk 2/3 below last and often more. Others shed more. Plainer types were similarly easier and suffered fair withdrawals.

Dust: Met with a good demand. All clean good liquoring types sold well at about firm rates. Others were mostly easier with some withdrawals. Clean primary CD's were a strong feature.

Comment: Offering this week witnessed a less exciting market with major Buyers operating on lower limits and reduced strength. Prices as such, declined and a larger weight of tea remained unsold. Loose Tea Traders were rather selective. Well made good liquoring types however, continued to sell well but at lower levels than last.
