Brokens: Well made good liquoring types sold well at firm to little easier rates. Mediums sold about similarly. Plainer types were firm to irregularly, slightly easier.

Fannings: Best and the below best types were readily sold at mostly around last levels. Others were firm to a little easier. Plainer types were mostly firm.

Dust: Met with a fairly good demand. Clean good liquoring types were generally firm. Others were firm to often little easier. Cleaner CD's sold well whilst secondary types were neglected.

Comment: Blenders continued to be the major contender and accounted for majority of the teas sold. Well made good liquoring sorts readily sold at mostly firm rates. Cleaner Dusts were a good market. Loose Tea Traders were less active than last.
