Quality: Showed seasonal decline.

<u>Demand:</u> Less demand at easier rates with large withdrawals.

<u>Buyers:</u> Blenders were the major contenders. Loose Tea Traders were subdued.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: A smaller weight of the well made good liquoring types offered met with a good demand and sold at rates generally Tk. 3/5 easier than last. Others met with only a limited demand at rates Tk 5/7 lower with majority remaining unsold. Plainer types were mostly neglected.

Fannings: Likewise, best types were a fairly good market and sold at rates generally Tk. 3/5 below last. Others shed more with heavy withdrawals. Plainer types were difficult of sale.

<u>Dust:</u> Select few popular best types sold well a around last levels. Others were easier by Tk 3/5. Plainer types were generally neglected and where sold, were heavily discounted.

<u>Comment:</u> Offering this week was the largest so far this season and comprised mostly of plain and poorer types. Support emanated mainly from the Blenders which however, was generally confined to the well made good liquoring types on offer. Loose Tea Traders were barely active. Demand slackened as sale progressed resulting in heavier withdrawals and substantially lower rates.
