Fannings: Best and the below best types met with a good demand and sold at rates generally around last. Mediums were easier by Tk 3/5 whilst plainer types met with a limited demand at further discounted rates.

Dust: Clean good liquoring varieties met with a fairly strong demand and sold at firm to dearer rates of Tk 5/7. Others were generally an easier market shedding Tk 3/5 from last with some withdrawals. Cleaner CD's were a strong feature.
