Brokens: Clean good liquoring types sold well but generally eased by around Tk. 5/7 from last. Medium and the plainer types shed more with fair withdrawals.

Fannings: Best and the below best types were a good market and sold at rates Tk 5/7 below last. Others eased more with a fair weight remaining unsold.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Fair demand at mostly around last rates.
