Tea Auctioneers since 1990 <u>TEA MARKET REPORT – SALE # 36</u>

The Sale # 36 held on Monday 17th January, 2022. The offerings comprised of 53,968 Pkgs of Leaf and 10,447 Pkgs of Dust on offer met with fairly good demand at irregular rates.

<u>CTC</u> <u>LEAF</u>: A small weight of well made Brokens with brighter cups met with strong competition and sold at firm to a dearer rates. Mediums categories met with good demand but prices eased in value and there were some withdrawals. Plainer types saw little demand at easier rates. BLF teas met with irregular demand at easier rates selling between Tk.125/- to Tk.150/- per kilo with some withdrawals.

Best liquoring Fannings continued to meet with good competition and prices were about firm to a dearer market. Mediums & plainer types met with less demand at easier rates and there were some withdrawals. BLF teas witnessed good demand from major Blenders but prices eased over last.

<u>DUST</u>: Good liquoring RDs, PDs and Dust met with good demand and prices were about firm on last. Clean CDs met good demand and sold well while BLFs met limited interest with some withdrawals.

<u>COMMENTS</u> : A small weight of clean, bright liquoring tea on offer were keenly sought after and these types sold at fully firm to a dearer market. Mediums met with irregular demand and prices were easier over last. Plainer types saw little demand at much easier rates while BLFs especially the smaller grades sold well.
