LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: A handful of the best types available met with a fairly strong market and sold at firm to dearer rates following quality. Below best types met with a fairly good demand but were little easier. Medium and the plainer types met with less demand and ruled easier with fair withdrawals.

<u>Fannings:</u> A small weight of the best types offered met with a fairly strong market and sold at firm to dearer rates. All others met with only a fair demand at easier rates of Tk 2/3 with some withdrawals.





<u>Dust:</u> Clean good liquoring types sold readily at generally firm rates. Others were easier with some withdrawals. CD's sold well especially the cleaner types.

<u>Comment:</u> A limited weight of the clean good liquoring types offered were the brightest feature of the sale. These were well competed for by all sections of the market. All others met with only a fair demand at generally easier rates with fair withdrawals. Cleaner Dusts were a good seller.
