Quality: Generally plain and end season type.

Demand: Less demand at easier rates with fairly heavy withdrawals.

Buyers: Blenders operated only fairly actively whilst Loose Tea Traders were somewhat selective.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: A small weight of the clean good liquoring types offered, met with a fair demand at little easier rates with some withdrawals. Below best and the mediums met with less demand at easier rates and a fair weight remained unsold. Plainer types followed suit.

Fannings: Best and the below best types met with a fairly good demand at generally easier rates of Tk 3/5 with some remaining unsold. Mediums and the plainer types met with less demand at generally easier rates and there were fair withdrawals.

Dust: Met with a fairly good demand. Clean good liquoring types were firm to little easier whilst rest were easier with some withdrawals.

Comment: Quality on offer was generally plain and end season type. Blenders as well as the Loose Tea Traders operated on lower limits and were apparently rather selective. Prices were mostly easier and a substantial weight remained unsold owing to lack of demand.
