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TEA MARKET REPORT – Sale 34 held on Monday 3rd January, 2022

CTC LEAF: 51,210 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with an improved demand.

BROKENS: Good liquoring varieties met with a good demand and were mostly firm to occasionally dearer. Medium varieties saw more demand but eased a little. Likewise, plain types saw fair demand but prices were much lower than last and there were several withdrawals. BLF types saw a little more demand and again eased.

FANNINGS: A fair weight of good liquoring Fannings saw strong competition and were mostly dearer often substantially. Good types witnessed fair demand and were about steady. Medium and plainer varieties met with less competition and prices declined further. There were also some withdrawals in this category. BLFs saw some enquiry at lower rates.

CTC DUST: 10,519 packages of Current Season on offer met with improved demand. All good and medium Dusts were a dearer market and advanced by Tk.5/- to Tk.10/- closely following quality. Plainer Dusts also sold well at around last levels. BLF Dusts on offer sold readily at slightly easier rates with few withdrawals. Blenders lent good support with a little more interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: After weeks of weak demand, there was some improvement this week in this area whereby more teas were sold albeit at much easier rates. The feature of the sale was the strong competition for all good liquoring varieties particularly in the Fannings category. Blenders lent stronger support with a little more interest from the Internal Loose tea buyers.

Dusts sold well.

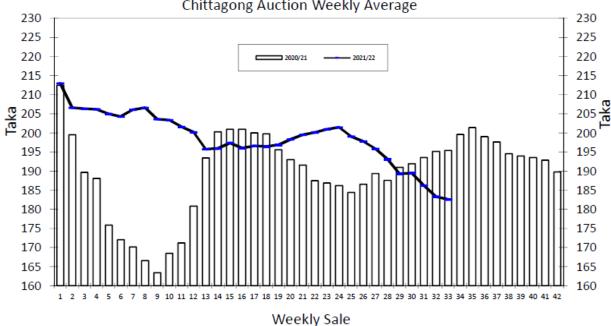

CTC Leaf: There was good demand. Bulk of the good & medium Assams on offer sold readily at easier rates following a seasonal decline in quality. Better & clean well-made medium Dooars descriptions sold around last levels. Plainer Dooars were irregular and mostly easier. Dust: There was good demand. Select best liquoring descriptions sold well with competition. The remainder was irregular and easier closely following quality. M/s Tata Consumer Products was active in the leaf sale and operated on a wide range of the offerings. They showed lesser interest in the dust sale. M/s Hindustan Unilever was active primarily on brighter liquoring Assams in both markets. Western India segments were active on good liquoring sorts. Regional packeteers extended useful support on a cross-section of the offerings, more so in the plainer categories. Export accounts operated on larger Brokens. Local buyers were active on the Dooars.
