## MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO. 42 HELD ON FEBRUARY 28, 2022

26,585 packages leaf alongwith 688 packages of leaf supplements were advertised for sale. There was a good initial demand at lower rates than last. Prices eased towards close with fair withdrawals. Leaf withdrawals stood at $24 \%$ as against $28 \%$ last week.
LFAF: There was a good demand for the medium and plainer teas when the sale opened but prices were Tk. $5 / 8$ below last rates. A small quantity of good teas eased. Selective best lines sold between Tk.201/- to Tk.217/-. Northern brokens sold between Tk.115/-Tk.150/-.

Fannings were a good market initially and prices were lower by Tk.5/6. However towards close, demand eased and withdrawals were higher. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.205/- to Tk.220/-. Northern fannings sold between Tk.130/- to Tk.167/-.
DUST: 6,755 packages alongwith 683 packages of supplements were on offer. There was a good demand. Better teas were about firm: Mediums often gained. Dust withdrawals stood at $29 \%$ as against $23 \%$ last week.
