LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: A nominal weight of good liquoring types offered met with a fairly strong demand and sold at firm to generally dearer rates. Medium and plainer types met with an improved demand and were also firm to dearer following quality. Poorer types however, were easier and suffered some withdrawal.

Fannings: Likewise, a few lines of clean good liquoring types available were a dearer market whilst, others were generally firm and little dearer in line with quality. Poorer types were neglected and where sold, were discounted.
