Quality: Similar to last.

Demand: Fairly good demand with Buyers following quality

Buyers: Blenders were active. Loose Tea Traders lent fairly good support.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Select few well made, bright liquoring types offered met with a strong demand and sold at substantially dearer rates following competition. Below best types were about steady. Mediums were easier by Tk. 5/10 with some withdrawals. Plainer types sold about similarly.

Fannings: Select few popular best liquoring types were a strong market and ruled dearer. Rest were easier by Tk 3/5 with some withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a limited demand and generally sold at between Tk. 125/140.
