**Buyers:** Blenders lent good support. Loose Tea Traders were active.

## LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types were readily absorbed at firm rates. Below best and the Mediums were about steady. Plainer types met with selective demand and were generally easier.

**Fannings:** Best and the below best types met with a good market and sold at rates firm to slightly easier than last following quality. Mediums met with a fair demand at around last levels. Plainer types were easier.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a limited demand and generally sold at between Tk. 128/138.

Dust: Clean good liquoring RD's and Dust were a good market and mostly sold at around last levels. Others were little easier. CD's met with a fairly strong demand and generally sold at around last levels particularly the cleaner sorts. Rest however, were easier.

Comment: Well made useful liquoring descriptions were keenly sought after by all sections of the market and there generally sold at firm to occasionally a little dearer rates. Rest met with only a fair demand. Plainer types suffered fair withdrawals. Dusts were a good market.
