CTC LEAF: Well made Brokens with brighter cups once again met with strong demand and mostly sold at fully firm to a dearer rates often advancing Tk.5/- to Tk.10/- per kilo. Their mediums and others categories met with fair demand but the prices declined by Tk.5/- to Tk.10/- per kilo. Plainer categories met with irregular demand and sold at easier rates and a fair quantity remained unsold without any bids.

BLFs categories met fair demand and mostly sold at easier rates often declined by Tk,10/- and above and there were some withdrawals.

All good liquoring Fannings were in strong demand & mostly sold at fully firm to a dearer market often advancing by upto Tk.10/- and above.
