Fannings: Best and the below best types met with a fairly strong demand and sold at levels generally firm on last. Occasional lines appreciated with competition. Other mostly held on to last rates.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a fair demand. Prices were generally firm to little dearer following quality. There were however, fair withdrawals.
