Quality: Maintained.

Demand: Good general demand at firm to occasionally slightly dearer rates following quality.

Buyers: Blenders operated actively with fairly good support from the Loose Tea Traders.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well-made good liquoring types met with fairly strong demand and mostly sold at firm rates. Below best and the mediums met with an improved demand and were generally firm to occasionally little dearer. Others were steady.

Fannings: Best and below best types were keenly sought after by all sections of the market and sold at rates generally firm on last. Others met with a good demand and sold at around last levels.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with an improved demand. Better types sold between Tk. 140-155/= whilst rest fetched between Tk. 120-138/=. There were however, some withdrawals.
