MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO.17 HELD ON AUGUST 29,2022


Offerings comprising of 36,252 packages of leaf alongwith 933 packages of supplements met strong general demand, better off-takes and improved rates. Withdrawals stood at 27% against 27% last week.


LEAF: Good liquoring well made brokens were well sought after at fully firm to dearer rates of Tk.2/5 and occasionally more. Mediums and plainer types also moved up by Tk.2/4. Northern's sold at fully firm and often dearer rates. Selective best brokens sold at around Tk.245/- to Tk.403/-.

Best and good fannings met strong demand and higher rates of Tk.2/4. Mediums and plainer fannings also were a dearer market. Northern brokens sold at firm to occasionally much dearer rates. Selective best fannings sold between Tk.244/- to Tk.380/-.

DUST: 8,816 packages alongwith 619 packages of dust came under the hammer. There was strong demand with the well made dust and powdery sorts moving up by Tk.2/3 and occasionally more. Others were about firm to irregularly dearer. Withdrawals stood at 23% against 19% last week.
