LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Clean good liquoring types met with a strong demand and sold at rates Tk. 5/10 above last and occasionally a little more. Mediums sold well and levels Tk. 5/7 above last. Plain types were dearer.

Fannings: Best and the below best types were a strong market and were generally dearer by around Tk. 10/=. Mediums gained a little less. Plain types too, shared the upward trend of the market.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a better demand and sold at dearer rates of Tk. 5/10. There were however, some withdrawals.
