Offering: Dust: (In pkgs) 41,941 (49,476) 8,007 (12,082)

(Last year in brackets)

Quality: Mostly around last.

**Demand:** Strong demand especially for the cleaner types.

**Buyers:** Blenders were the major contenders. Loose Tea Traders lent only a fair support.

## **LEAF-CTC:**

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types were a strong feature and sold at firm to dearer rates of Tk. 3/5 following competition. Below best and mediums were firm. Plainer types were firm to little easier following quality.

Fannings: Clean good liquoring types were a strong market and sold at firm to dearer rates of Tk. 3/5 and occasionally a little more. Others were mostly firm. Plainer types were steady to often little easier with quality.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with only a fair demand. Prices mostly ranged between Tk. 135/165 following quality. There were however, some withdrawals.

<u>Dust:</u> Met with a good demand. Clean bright liquoring sorts were firm. Rests were mostly easier by Tk. 3/5. There were some withdrawals.

Comment: There was sustained demand for the well made good liquoring descriptions on offer which sold at rates generally firm to dearer than last. Rests were about steady. Poorer types were discounted and often neglected. Blenders were active whilst Loose Tea Traders were less supportive than last.
