Quality: Similar to last.

Demand: Fairly strong demand for well made good liquoring types. Others met with only a fair demand.

Buyers: Blenders lent useful support whilst Loose Tea Traders were rather selective.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types were keenly sought after mainly by the Blenders and these generally sold at firm rates. Below best and the mediums were firm to generally easier by Tk. 3/5. Plainer types eased about similarly with some withdrawals.

Fannings: Best and the below best types were a fairly strong market and sold mostly at around last levels. Mediums were firm to little easier following quality. Plainer types were easier with some withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a fair demand. Prices ranged between Tk. 135/160 following quality. There were however, fairly large withdrawals.

Dust: Clean bright liquoring types were a good market and generally sold at around last levels. Others were easier by Tk. 3/5. There were some withdrawals in the plainer category.
