Quality: About maintained.

Demand: Fairly strong demand at around last levels especially for the better types on offer.

Buyers: Blenders were active. Loose Tea Traders lent only a fair support.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Better types sold readily at firm rates. Below best and the mediums were firm to little easier with quality. Plainer types were steady but suffered fair withdrawals.

Fannings: Best and the below best types were a fairly strong market and ruled firm on last. Mediums sold at around last. Plainer types were about firm with fair withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a limited demand at between Tk. 135/160 per kg.
