Well made BOPs with brighter cups met with fairly good demand and mostly sold at fully firm to a dearer rates. Neatly made GBOPs were in strong demand and mostly sold at-fully firm to a dearer rates following make & quality. Their mediums were about firm while Plainer categories met with irregular demand and sold at easier rates with some withdrawals.

BLF categories met with irregular demand and only well made types were about steady while others declined in value with fair withdrawals

All good liquoring coloury Fannings with brighter cups were in strong demand & mostly sold at fully firm to a dearer rates often advancing by up to Tk.5/- and more. Below best types were about steady while Plainer types were an easier feature with some withdrawals. BLFs saw irregular demand and sold at around last levels.
