MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO. 20 HELD ON SEPTEMBER 19, 2022


41,268 packages of leaf alongwith 1,988 packages of leaf supplements were on offer. Most cleaner teas were firm to generally dearer. Poorer teas and those from the North met with fair withdrawals. Leaf withdrawals stood at 42% as against 43% last week.


LFAF: Cleaner well made and the medium brokens were firm to dearer by Tk.2/3. Inferior lines and the Northern teas eased and met with fair withdrawals. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.248/- to Tk.267/-. Northern brokens fetched between Tk.125/- to Tk.167.

Well made fannings were a dearer market. Mediums were about firm. Lower types eased and met with withdrawals. Selective best lines sold between Tk.245/- to Tk.259/-. Northern fannings sold between Tk.126/- to Tk.168/-.

DUST: 7,836 packages alongwith 627 packages of supplements were on offer. There was a good demand at lower rates than last. Dust withdrawals stood at 37% as against 42% last week.

<u>COMMENTS</u>: Good teas met with a strong demand at firm to dearer rates. Lower types declined. There was a large volume of the "strike period" teas and a bigger quantity will be on offer in the next sale. Packeteers were strong for most cleaner teas with a good cup which will be in short supply in the next two weeks.
