Quality: Showed some decline.

Demand: Good demand with Buyers following quality.

Buyers: Blenders lent useful support. Loose Tea Traders were fairly active.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Better types met with a good demand and sold at firm to easier rates of Tk. 3/5 following quality. Select few lines of best types offered were a strong feature and ruled dearer. Rest were easier with fair withdrawals.

Fannings: Cleaner types were readily absorbed by all sections of the market at levels firm to little easier than last. A handful of the best types available were a strong market and sold at higher rates. Others were easier with fair withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a fair demand at little easier rates generally selling between Tk. 125/155 per kg.

Dust: A limited weight of well made good liquoring types offered sold well at about firm rates. Others were generally easier and suffered some withdrawals.

Comment: There was an overall decline in the quality on offer. A handful of the best types available met with a strong demand. Better types were firm whilst brown, plainer sorts were discounted with fair withdrawals. Dust followed the trend of the Leaf market.
