TEA MARKET REPORT – SALE # 25

The Sale # 25 held on Monday 24th October 2022. The offerings comprised of 54,742 Pkgs of Leaf and 12,086 Pkgs of Dust on offer met with improved demand for well made types only.

LEAF : A small selection of well made BOPs with brighter cups were in strong competition and mostly sold at fully firm to a dearer rates often advancing Tk.10/- and more . Neatly made GBOPs were keenly sought after and mostly sold at premium rates . Medium types were about firm while Plainer categories met with less demand and sold at easier rates with fair withdrawals.

BLF types met with selective demand and well made types sold at easier rates while others were difficult to sell and there were heavy withdrawals

All good liquoring coloury Fannings with brighter cups were in strong demand & mostly sold at fully firm to a dearer rates often advancing by up to Tk.10/- and more. Below best types were about firm while Plainer types were an easier feature with some withdrawals. BLFs saw irregular demand and sold at around last levels.

DUST : Good liquoring Dust met with good demand and sold at firm levels. Below best and medium types were about steady while plainer categories shed in value by Tk.5/- to Tk.10/- per kilo. Clean CDs met with improved demand and sold at premium rates. BLF categories met with less demand & witnessed more withdrawals.

COMMENTS: Once again demand evoked for a small selection of well made, good liquoring tea on offer met with strong demand and these types were readily absorbed at premium rates. Major Blenders and Bazaar lent strong support. BLF types met selective demand at easier rates and a fair quantity remained unsold.
