## MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO. 25 HELD ON OCTOBER 24,2022

54,016 packages of leaf on offer met selective demand and irregular rates. Well made good liquoring teas were firm to dearer. Others met lower rates and largs scale withdrawals. Withdrawals stood at $41 \%$ against $37 \%$ last week.

LEAF: Good liquoring well made brokens were fully firm to often dearer by Tk.5/10 and occsionally more. Others met easier rates with fair withdrawals. Selective best lines sold between Tk.257/- to Tk.417/-.

Best and good fannings were firm to ocassionally dearer by Tk.2/5. Mediums eased and the plain poor types, where sold shed further. Selective best lines sold between Tk.250/-to Tk.395/-.

DUST: There were 11,336 packages on offer. Good liquoring Dust and the clean powdery CD's were firm to dearer. Others met lower rates. Withdrawals stood at 34\% against 32\% last week.

SUPPLEMENTS: 760 packages leaf and 766 packages dust came under the hammer. $21 \%$ sold and $79 \%$ remained unsold.



SALE NO:- 26 will be held on October 31, 2022 at 8:30 A.M. in Chattogram. Total offerings will comprise of 58,400 packages leaf and 13,016 packages dust.

COMMENTS: Market for the well made and good liquoring teas was fully firm to dearer following strong competition amongst packeteers and local traders. Teas of indifferent make and defective liquors met substantial withdrawals and much lower rates. Next sale No. 26 with 71,416 packages is the largest offering so far this season.
