LEAF-CTC:

<u>Brokens:</u> Well made good liquoring types were a strong market and sold at dearer rates, often substantially. Below best and the mediums were firm to Tk. 5/= easier than last. Plainer types met with only a limited demand.

Fannings: Best types were a strong feature and often appreciated in value following competition. Others were firm to little easier following quality. Plainer types were easier with some withdrawals.

<u>Bought-Leaf Teas:</u> Met with fair demand and mostly sold at around last levels. There were however, fair withdrawals.
