LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types were readily absorbed at about firm rates. Below best and the mediums about maintained last levels. Plainer types were easier and often neglected.

Fannings: Best and below best types were a fairly strong market and sold at firm rates. Others were steady. Plain and the poorer types were mostly neglected and where sold, eased.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Limited demand at easier rates with many withdrawals.
