MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO.19 HELD ON SEPTEMBER 04,2023

53,770 packages came under the hammer. After a hesitant start demand showed some improvement and prices were firm to little easier. Withdrawals stood at 50% against 46% last week.


LEAF: Best and good brokens were about firm to a slightly dearer following quality. Mediums eased by Tk.3/5 whilst the plainer sorts declined more and met withdrawals. Some selective best lines fetched between Tk.236/- to Tk.375/-. Northern teas were generally easier with quite a large quantity remaining unsold.


Best and good fannings met good demand and prices were mostly about firm to occasionally dearer for the better types. Mediums were firm to generally easier by Tk.2/4. Plainer types eased by Tk.4/5 and saw fair withdrawals. Selective best types sold around Tk.232/- to Tk.370/-. Northern fannings where sold were mostly easier.

DUST: There were 9,429 packages on offer. Demand was selective and followed quality closely. Good liquoring types were about firm to slightly easier. Others were generally easier with a fair quantity remaining unsold. Withdrawals stood at 41% against 28% last week.

SUPPLEMENTS E-AUCTION: 3,785 packages were on offer. 15% sold and 85% remained unsold.

SALE NO:- 20 will be held on September 11, 2023 at 8:30 A.M. in Chattogram. Total offerings will comprise of 69,622 packages leaf and 12,011 packages of dust.

COMMENTS: Market saw good demand for the better teas. Others, particularly the plainer types and Northern teas were generally easier and met quite substantial withdrawals totalling 51% overall. Packeteers and local buyers were selective.
