## MARKET REPORT OH SALE NO 28 HELD OH NOVEMEER O6,2023

Offerings comprised of 69,287 packages leaf. Demand and prices were irregular with fairly large withdrawals which stood at $54 \%$ against $51 \%$ last week.

LEAF: Best types were about firm to slightly easier. Good brokens were firm to mostly easier. Medium and plainer varieties met irregular rates and generally easier. Northern teas were firm to easier. Some poor varieties sold at Tk.88.00 to Tk.132.00. Selective best types sold around Tk.235.00 - Tk.407.00.

Best and Good fannings were about firm to often easier. Medium and plainer varieties were easier from last rates. Northern fannings were about firm to mostly easier. Poor types sold at Tk. 90.00 - Tk.130.00. Selective best varieties sold between Tk. 234.00 Tk.326.00.

DUST: 9,945 packages were on offer. There was good demand for the well made good liqunring dusts and clean powdery types at firm to dearer rates. Others were an irregular market. Withdrawals stood at $34 \%$ against $29 \%$ last week.

SUPPI EMENTS+E-AUCTION: 5,218 packages were on offer. $35 \%$ sold with $65 \%$ remaining unsold.



SALE NO:- Sale 29 will be held on November 13, 2023 at 8:30 A.M. in Chattogram. Total offerings will comprise of 70,057 packages leaf and 13,792 packages of dust.

COMMENTS: Offerings were larger than the previous sale and stood at 85,603 packages. Demand was selective and met irregular rates. Better teas were a firm market. Most others were easier and a fairly large quantity remained unsold. Total withdrawals stood at $53 \%$ against $49 \%$ last week. Packeters were fairly active. Internal buying was confined to the best and cheaper teas.
