76,051 packages of leaf came under the hammer this sale. There was very selective demand for the better teas at easier rates. Others met very limited interest and large scale withdrawals. Leaf withdrawals stood at 63% as against 56% last week.

LEAF: Better teas had fair demand but at rates easier than last week. Mediums sold at rates easier by Tk.5/8. Plainer teas where sold were much easier and met with withdrawals. Some very poor lines sold between Tk.95.00 to Tk.135.00. Northern brokens sold between Tk.75.00 to Tk.141.00. Selective best types sold between Tk.227.00 to Tk.354.00.


Best and good fannings were easier by Tk.8/10. Mediums declined by Tk.10/12. Plainer types sold at much lower rates and often met withdrawals. Some poor lines sold between Tk.95.00 to Tk.132.00. Northern fannings sold between Tk.91.00 to Tk.135.00. Selective best varieties sold around Tk.218.00 to Tk.325.00.


OLD SEASON: Few old season teas sold between Tk.115.00 to Tk.125.00.

<u>DUST</u>: 11,490 packages were on offer. Better types were steady. Others were easier and met withdrawals. Dust withdrawals stood at 40% as against 39% last week.
