MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 29 HELD ON NOVEMBER 13,2023

66.818 packages of leaf were on offer. Weaker demand led to a slide of prices and withdrawals which stood at 53% as against 54% last week.


LEAF: Well made brokens were in good demand but prices eased by Tk.5/8. Mediums and the plainer lines shed more. Some very poor lines sold between Tk.75/- to Tk.118/-. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.217/- to Tk.250/-. Northern brokens fetched between Tk.80/- to Tk.141/-.


Good fannings were well sought after at easier rates than last. Mediums were easier by Tk.10/- to Tk.15/-. Plainer lines lost more. Some very poor lines sold between Tk.72/- to Tk.119/-. Selective best lines sold between Tk.220/- to Tk.256/-. Northern fannings sold between Tk.90/- to Tk.140/-.

DUST: 11,314 packages were on offer. There was a better demand for the dusts but prices were generally easier. Powdery lines sold well. Withdrawals stood at 37% as against 34% last week.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 5,209 packages were on offer. 35% sold and 65% remained unsold.

COMMENTS: Major packeteers were active for their types but at much reduced rates. Local traders were quite subdued. Movement of teas have been adversely effected by the present situation which led prices to ease and high withdrawals.
