Quality: Showed some decline.

Demand: Less demand at further reduced levels.

Buyers: Packeteers were the major out-lets. Loose Tea Traders were rather selective.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Good liquoring sorts were readily absorbed at easier rates of Tk. 5/10 from last. Others met with less demand at similarly easier rates. A fair weight however, remained unsold.

Fannings: Clean good liquoring types met with a fairly good demand and sold at rates Tk. 5/10 easier than last. Others were easier and suffered fair withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a limited demand. Prices generally ranged between Tk 110/120 with select few better types fetching more.

Dust: Met with less demand and prices eased further by Tk. 5/10 from last. Withdrawals were quiet substantial.

Comment: Offering was larger this week which however, witnessed less demand at further reduced levels. Major blenders operated on reduced strength and held lower limits. Prices were generally down by Tk. 5/10 and a substantial weight remained unsold owing to lack of demand. Dusts followed the trend of the leaf market.
