Tea Auctioneers since 1948 TEA MARKET REPORT – Sale 22 held on Monday 25th September, 2023

CTC LEAF: 76,297 packages of tea on offer met with a fair demand with heavier withdrawals.

BROKENS: A few select lines of good Brokens met with a fair demand and sold at around last levels but all others declined in price and witnessed heavy withdrawals, particularly the plainest. BLF teas met with less demand with much more withdrawals.

FANNINGS: A few lines of good Fannings met with a fairly good demand and mostly sold at around last levels and often shedding Tk.2/- to Tk.4/-. Medium Fannings met with less demand and where sold recorded a further drop and there were more withdrawals. Plain types witnessed much less demand and were mostly withdrawn owing to lack of bids. BLF teas met with less demand with much more withdrawals

CTC DUST: 14,388 packages of tea on offer met with a good demand. Good liquoring Dusts met with good demand at easier rates. Medium teas met with a fair demand with some withdrawals. Plain and BLF Dusts met with less demand and had some withdrawals. Blenders were fairly active. Loose tea buyers were selective.

COMMENTS: A record weight of tea was on offer in this sale which mainly comprised of reprints from the previous sales. Blenders lent fairly good support but were holding lower limits. There was less demand from the Loose tea buyers particularly for the re-printed teas.

Dusts met with fair demand with less withdrawals than last.



DEMAND:- Good demand. MARKET:- The total CTC leaf teas sold this week was 93.64 % (1487723.30kgs) of the total offering of 1588844.43Kgs. The brighter teas sold at irregularly easier prices in line with quality. However, the larger weight of teas in this category remained unsold due to lack of bids. Good category teas sold firm. Better medium teas sold firm to dearer, on competition. The medium & plainer larger broken grades sold fully firm whilst the other grades sold barely steady. BUYING PATTERN: - The major blenders absorbed 46.81% of the total CTC leaf sold quantity. Regional packeteers were choosy on best, good and better medium teas. Up country buyers and local traders were rather subdued this week. Exporters were fairly active on larger broken grades of the medium and plainer category teas, especially on the blacker sorts.
