CTC LEAF: 63,365 packages of tea on offer met with an improved demand.

BROKENS: All good liquoring Brokens met with a better demand and were fully firm to slightly dearer following competition. Other varieties also met with a fairly good demand but were slightly easier in line with quality. Plain types were again a slightly easier market with some withdrawals. BLF teas met with a fair demand at around last levels with some withdrawals.

FANNINGS: Good liquoring Fannings met with a fairly strong demand and were again fully firm to slightly dearer following competition. Medium varieties met with a fair demand and sold at around last levels easing in line with quality. Plain types were

again slightly easier with some withdrawals. BLF teas met with a fair demand at around last levels with some withdrawals.

CTC DUST: 11,662 packages of tea on offer met with good demand. Good liquoring Dusts sold well at dearer rates. Mediums were in fair demand with few withdrawals. Plain and BLF Dusts had fair demand with some withdrawals. Blenders were active with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: There was a slightly improved demand this week mainly emanating from the Major Blenders. Loose tea buyers lent a little more support. All good liquoring varieties met with a little more competition than last.

CDs sold well at dearer prices.


