Tea Market Report

## MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 30 HELD ON NOVEMBER 20,2023

71,779 packages of leaf were advertised for sale. Demand weakened further and with it, prices moved further down. Leaf withdrawals stood at 62% as against 53% last week.


LEAF: Good brokens received support from the buyers at generally easier rates. Only few lines held firm. Mediums and the plainer teas depreciated Tk.10/15 with large withdrawals. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.215/- to Tk.258/-. Some very poor lines sold between Tk.80/- to Tk.112/- whilst the northern brokens sold between Tk.80/- to Tk.139/-.


Better fannings were occasionally competed for at little lower rates than last. Mediums and the plainer types eased by Tk.10/- or more. Selective best lines sold between Tk.219/- to Tk.248/-. Some very poor lines fetched between Tk.71.00- Tk.115.00. Northern fannings ranged between Tk.85/- to Tk.138/-.

<u>DUST</u>: 11,066 packages were on offer. Prices were generally lower than last. Well made nowdery lines met with a good competiton and often moved up. Dust withdrawals stood at 35% as against 37% last week.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 6,220 packages were on offer. 31% sold and 69% remained unsold.

SALE NO:- Sale 31 will be held on November 27, 2023 at 8:30 A.M. in Chattogram. Total offerings will comprise of 72,913 packages leaf and 14,493 packages of dust.

COMMENTS: Demand continued to weaken with prices falling further as buyers indicate to poor sales. Withdrawals are getting larger as more teas remain unsold. Buyers were generally selective.
