### TEA MARKET REPORT – Sale 35 held on Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> December, 2023

CTC LEAF: 67,810 packages of tea on offer met with quite a good demand.

BROKENS: Well made Brokens were a good market particularly the smaller varieties which were firm to occasionally dearer. Other varieties met with a little less demand and were mostly easier with quite fair withdrawals. Plainer varieties again witnessed less demand at easier rates with quite heavy withdrawals. BLF teas met with a selective demand at easier rates with more withdrawals.

FANNINGS: A handful of good liquoring Fannings were a strong market and were mostly firm to slightly dearer following competition. Other varieties met with quite a fair demand but prices eased further with more withdrawals. Plain teas once again met with limited demand and prices eased with heavier withdrawals. BLF teas met with a selective demand at easier rates with more withdrawals.

**DUST**: 17,527 packages of tea on offer met with fair demand. Good liquoring Dusts met with a fair demand and sold Tk.3/- to Tk.5/- less than last levels. Mediums were an easier market and sold around Tk.5/- to Tk.10/- less than last with some withdrawals. Plain and BLF Dusts continued to be difficult of sale and with heavy withdrawals. Blenders were fairly active whilst Loose tea buyers were selective.

**COMMENTS:** A few well made good liquoring varieties were well competed for by all sections of the market. Blenders lent more support than last week with little more interest from the Loose tea buyers. However, the bulk of the offerings which were reprinted teas continued to suffer both in price and withdrawal.

Good liquoring Dusts sold well whilst others had heavy withdrawals.

Good demand on the best teas. Fair demand on the remainders. The total CTC leaf teas sold this week was 87.13% (1206830.68kgs) of the total offering of 1385037.22Kgs. The best liquoring teas sold well in line with quality with select flavory invoices fetching handsome gains on competition. Good and better medium teas sold at last levels. Medium & plainer category larger and select medium broken sold fully firm. Smaller Broken and Fanning were barely steady. There were a quantum of teas in this category that remained unsold due to lack of bids. Browner sorts were discounted. The major blenders continued to be selective and absorbed around 29.44% of the total CTC leaf sold quantity. Regional packeteer's were active on the best and good teas. Up country buyers and local traders were subdued. Exporters were selective on the better medium, medium and plainer category larger and medium Broken grades.
