

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO.15 HELD ON AUGUST 07,2023

59,600 packages of leaf were advertised for sale. Less demand led to a decline in prices with fair withdrawals. Leaf withdrawals stood at 48% as against 40% last week.

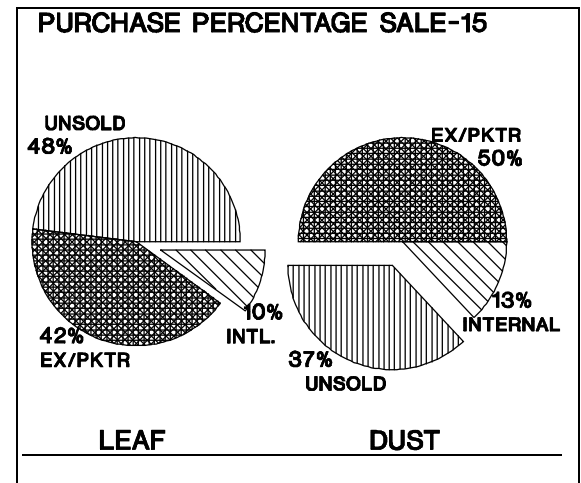
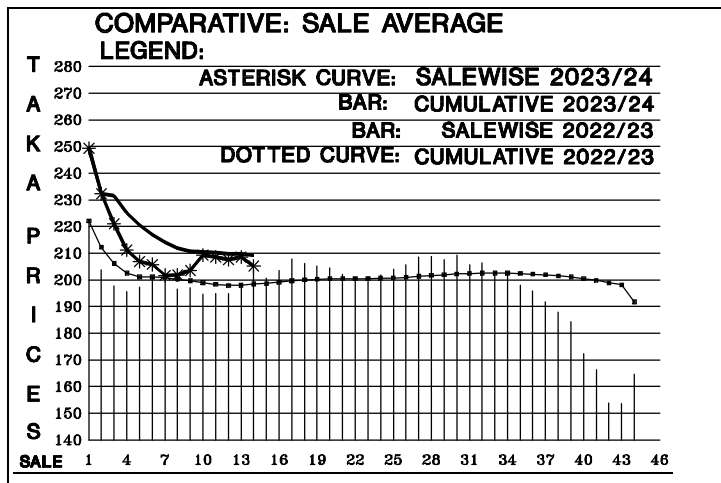
LEAF: Good brokens eased by Tk.8/10. High priced lines shed between Tk.15/20. Mediums depreciated by Tk.10/15. Plain lines met with large withdrawals. Selective best lines sold between Tk.236/- to Tk.279/-. Northern brokens ranged between Tk.108/- to Tk.132/-.

Better fannings came to a lower market and eased by Tk.5/10. Mediums shed more as did the lower types. Selective best lines fetched between Tk.235/- to Tk.248/-. Northern fannings sold between Tk.109/- to Tk.145/-.

DUST: 12,054 packages were on offer. Limited demand led to easier prices as levels moved downwards by Tk.10/15 or more. Dust withdrawals stood at 37% as against 30% last week.

SUPPLEMENTS E-AUCTION: 5,138 packages were on offer. 63% sold and 37% remained unsold.

COMMENTS: A much weaker demand was witnessed in this sale with prices declining by Tk.5/15 and more for the high priced teas. Northern teas continued to be neglected and met with large withdrawals.
