Quality: Showed some declined.

Demand: Fairly strong demand for the cleaner types whilst others met with a good demand.

Buyers: Blenders were active. Loose Tea Traders lent fairly good support.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: A small weight of the clean good liquoring type offered met with a fairly strong demand and sold at firm to occasionally little dearer rates. Below best and the mediums were firm. Plain types were irregularly easier.

Fannings: A handful of the cleaner types offered met with a strong demand and ruled firm to occasionally dearer following competition. Rest were firm. Plain types were irregularly little easier.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a fair demand at generally around last levels. Select few better types however, were slightly dearer.
