LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: A negligible weight of cleaner types offered sold well at firm to easier rates of Tk. 5/7. Mediums shed more. Plainer types met with selective interest at easier rates of Tk 5/10 and a fair weight remained unsold.

Fannings: Likewise, a nominal weight of the brighter types available sold readily at firm to easier rates of Tk. 5/7 and occasionally more. Rest met with only a fair demand at easier rates of Tk 5/10 with fair withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Selective demand. Better types were firm whilst others were easier and mostly remained unsold.
