Demand: Fair demand at easier rates.

Buyers: Blenders tended selective. Loose Tea Traders lent a limited support.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: A few lines of the cleaner types offered sold well at generally firm rates. Rest were easier by Tk 5/10 and a fair weight remained unsold owing to lack of interest. There was however, some interest at the lower end of the market.

Fannings: A handful of the better types available sold well at generally around last levels. Others met with a fair demand at easier rates of Tk. 5/10 with fair withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Limited demand. There were fair withdrawals.
