Offering: (In pkgs) **Leaf:** 61,570 (47,109) **Dust:** 12,713 (10,128)

Quality: Showed a general decline.

Demand: Good demand at mostly easier rates.

Buyers: Blenders were the major out-lets. Loose Tea Traders lent only a fair support.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Better types sold well at easier rates of Tk. 5/7. A few lines however, ruled firm to little dearer following competition. Others were easier and suffered fair withdrawals.

Fannings: Clean bright liquoring types sold well but eased by Tk. 3/5 from last. Select few lines, tended dearer owing to competition. Rests were easier with fair withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with selective demand at little easier rates. There were however, fairly large withdrawals.

Dust: Met with a fairly good demand. Clean good liquoring types sold readily at irregularly firm to generally easier rates. Rest were easier with some withdrawals.

Comment: A larger weight was offered this week and with quality showing an over-all decline, this sale met with an easier market. Major Blenders were active but closely followed quality. Loose Tea Traders were rather selective. Demand slackened as sale progressed leading to more withdrawals in the later part of the sale. Dusts followed the trend of the Leaf market and were generally easier. There were fair withdrawals.
