The Sale # 42 held on Monday 20th February 2023. The offerings comprised of 46,967 Pkgs of Leaf and 10,460 Pkgs of Dust on offer met with less demand and prices declined substantially with heavy withdrawals.

LEAF: A small quantity of good BOPs met with strong demand and sold at firm to a dearer rates. Their smaller types (GBOPs) with brighter cups met with keen competition and sold at a dearer rates. Medium categories met some demand but prices eased over last sale. Plain & poorer types saw irregular demand and prices declined substantially over last and there were heavy withdrawals. BLF teas met with fairly good demand following make & quality.

Fannings with brighter cups were in strong demand and mostly sold at fully firm to a dearer rates. Below best types saw good demand at firm rates while medium & Plainer types eased in value following less competition and there were heavy withdrawals. BLF teas met with fairly good demand following make & cup quality although withdrawal was heavy.
