

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO.34 HELD ON DECEMBER 26,2022

65,043 packages came under the hammer. Market met with selective demand at firm to lower rates than last. Withdrawals stood at 39% against 43% last week.


LEAF: Well made and better liquoring brokens met with a firm demand at rates similar to last. Mediums were easier on last levels. Plainer types were discounted heavily and often met withdrawals. Poorer types sold around Tk.109/- to Tk.128/-. Selective best lines sold between Tk.252/- to Tk.268


Better fannings were often dearer. Mediums eased from lastlevels. Plainers varieties were easier and met withdrawals. Poorer types sold between Tk.110/- to Tk.130/-. Selective best lines sold between Tk.254/- to Tk.265/-.

DUST:12.715 packages of dust came under the hammer. Well made and clean powdery types were fully firm. Others were generally an irregular market and mostly easier. Dust withdrawals stood at 33% against 30% last week.

SUPPLEMENTS: 866 packages of supplements were offered. 29% sold and 71% remained unsold.
