29,955 packages of leaf came under the hammer. There was a fair demand with prices following quality. Withdrawals stood at 37% against 50% last week.


LEAF: Well made better liquoring brokens were in demand and sold at firm rates. Other categories were often easier following quality. There were fair withdrawal for the poorer and plainer types. Poorer types sold between Tk.69/- to Tk.92/-. Selective best lines sold around Tk.255/- to Tk.270/-.


Better fannings met good demand and sold similar to last. Mediums and plainer had a fair demand with prices following quality. Poorer types sold between Tk.65/- to Tk.90/-. Selective best lines sold between Tk.243/- to Tk.264/.

DUST: 6,781 packages of Dust were on offer and met with a fair demand following quality. Dust withdrawals stood at 41% against 38% last week.

SUPPLEMENTS: 1,208 packages were on offer. 26% sold with 74% remaining unsold.
