Demand: Fairly good demand at easier levels.

Buyers: Blenders were selective. Loose Tea Traders were fairly active.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: A few lines of the better types offered sold well at around last levels. All others were easier with some withdrawals. There was more interest at the lower end of the market.

Fannings: A nominal weight of the better types available sold readily at about firm rates. Rest eased by Tk.5/10 with some withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Easier with some withdrawals.

Dust: Fair demand. Prices for all description were generally easier with some withdrawals. Select few cleaner types however, sold well but eased a little.
