The Sale # 04 held on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> May 2023. The offerings comprised of 31,592 Pkgs of Leaf (767 Pkgs of Old Season Teas) and 8,168 Pkgs of Dust (167 Pkgs of Old Season Teas) met with less demand at much easier rates with heavy withdrawals.

LEAF: Blackish, well made Brokens met with good demand but prices declined over last and these types were easier by Tk.10/- and more and with the progress of the sale – prices declined further. Medium categories saw good interest but were easier than last sale. Plainer types met with similar demand & withdrawals were heavy. BLF categories saw less interest at much easier rates with more withdrawals.

Well made Fannings met with good demand but prices dropped sharply by Tk. 10/- and more per kilo. Medium categories met with good demand and were easier by Tk.10/- to Tk.15/- per kilo. Plainer types saw less demand and a fair quantity remained unsold. BLF teas met less demand and sold at much easier rates with fair withdrawals.
